

New Parking Access Program for Island Residents

Town of New Shoreham Announces: Accessible Parking Permits for Auxiliary Lot at Point Judith

This initiative designates **22 reserved spaces** in the auxiliary lot at Point Judith for eligible residents, ensuring access even when Lot G is full.

Two Permit Types Available:

◆ Long-Term Seasonal Parking Permit

Ideal for residents with essential, ongoing needs such as:

- Frequent mainland medical visits
- Family member in extended care (hospital, rehab, nursing home)
- Other approved long-term needs

◆ Emergency Parking Permit (5-day maximum)

For urgent, short-term needs like:

- Medical or veterinary emergencies
- Critical family matters
- Urgent medical appointments or procedures

Eligibility & Guidelines

◆ Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a Block Island resident with a valid RI driver's license showing a Block Island address
- Must submit a completed application approved by the Human Services Director
- Must have a red, numbered placard issued by the Town

◆ Important Guidelines:

- One application per household
- 11 spaces (including 2 ADA spots) are reserved for each permit type
- In the case of high demand, a lottery system will be used
- Emergency permits valid for up to 5 days
- Placards must be displayed at all times and are non-transferable
- Misuse or failure to return placards may result in removal from the program
- Unauthorized vehicles will be towed by Northup's Towing at (401) 782-4280
